**Note :**

- The number of vacancies as also the number of reserved vacancies is provisional and may vary according to the actual requirement of the Bank.
- It is clarified that it may not be possible to employ Physically Challenged candidates in all Offices/ Branches of the Bank and they will have to work in the post identified by the Bank as suitable for them.
- As the reservation for Physically Challenged candidates is on horizontal basis, the selected candidates will be placed in the appropriate category (viz SC/ST/OBC/Gen) to which they belong.
- Please note that majority of vacancies for the post of Probationary Officers exist in the State of Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, M.P., Punjab, N.E. States etc.**

**Eligibility Criteria :**

**1. Nationality / Citizenship :**

A candidate must be either (i) a citizen of India, OR (ii) a subject of Nepal, OR (iii) subject of Bhutan, OR (iv) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before 1st January, 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India, OR (v) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India. Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (ii), (iii), (iv) & (v) above shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by the Government of India. A candidate in whose case a certificate of eligibility is necessary may be admitted to the examination/ interview conducted by the Bank but on final selection the offer of appointment may be given only after the necessary eligibility certificates has been issued to him by the Government of India.

**Note :**

- The relaxation in upper age limit is cumulative as per Govt of India guidelines.
- An ex- serviceman who has once joined a Government job on civil side after availing of the benefits given to him as an Ex-Serviceman for his re-employment, including a job in the Public Sector Undertaking ceases to enjoy ex-serviceman status for further employment.
- All persons eligible for age relaxation under 2 (4) above must produce the domicile certificate at the time of interview, from the District Magistrate in the Kashmir Division within whose jurisdiction he/ she had ordinarily resided or any other authority designated in this regard by the Govt. of Jammu & Kashmir, to the effect that the candidate had ordinarily been domiciled in the Kashmir Division of the state of Jammu & Kashmir during 1st January 1980 to 31st December 1989.
- Above relaxations are available only if the candidates fulfill the various conditions prescribed in the Govt. of India orders and instructions in this regard. To claim age relaxation, reserved category candidates should submit a copy of the Community Certificate.

**Definition : Physically Challenged Persons (PC) –**

Definition of Categories of Disabilities:

- An Orthopaedically Challenged (OC) person is one suffering from Locomotor Disability or Cerebral Palsy. Persons who suffer from not less than 40% of relevant disability (as certified by a Medical Board appointed by the Center/ State Govt) would be eligible for reservation in services/ posts.  
Locomotor Disability means disability of the bones, joints or muscles leading to substantial restriction of the movement of the limbs or any form of cerebral palsy. Cerebral Palsy means a group of non progressive conditions of a person characterized by abnormal motor control posture resulting from brain insult or injuries occurring in the pre-natal, peri-natal, or infant period of development.
- Deaf & Hearing Impaired (HI) : the deaf are those persons in whom the sense of hearing is non- functional for ordinary purposes of life i.e. total loss of hearing in both ears. They do not hear, understand sounds at all even with amplified speech. Hearing impairment means loss of sixty decibels or more in the better ear in the conversational range of frequencies.
- Visually Impaired : The visually impaired persons are those suffering from blindness or low vision.  
Blindness – refers to a condition where a person suffers from any of the following conditions  
(i) Total absence of sight, (ii) Visual acuity not exceeding 6/60 or 20/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with correcting lenses, (iii) Limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of 20 degree or worse.  
Person with low vision – means a person with impairment of visual functioning even after treatment or standard refractive correction, but who uses or is potentially capable of using vision for the planning or execution of a task with appropriate assistive device.

The visually impaired candidates and candidates whose writing speed is affected by cerebral palsy can use their own scribe at their cost during the written examination. In all such cases where a scribe is used, the following rules will apply :

The candidate will have to arrange his / her own scribe

- at his / her own cost.
- The academic qualification of the scribe should be one grade lower than the stipulated eligibility criteria.
- The scribe should be from any academic discipline for Probationary Officers, while for Specialist Officers the scribe should be from a discipline different from that of the candidate. The scribe should possess 60% or lesser marks.
- Both the candidate as well as the scribe will have to give a suitable undertaking, confirming that the scribe fulfills all the stipulated eligibility criteria for a scribe as mentioned above. Further, in case, it later transpires that he/ she did not fulfill any of the laid down eligibility criteria or suppresses material facts, the candidature of the applicant will stand cancelled, irrespective of the result of the written examination.
- Such candidates who use a scribe shall be eligible for extra time of 20 minutes for every hour of the examination.

**Note :**

- Application fee including postage should be paid by a single Demand Draft / Bankers' Cheque issued by a Scheduled Commercial Bank for each post separately to be drawn as below – "Allahabad Bank Recruitment Account – Probationary Officers Project" payable at Mumbai. **Selection Procedure :** Merely satisfying the eligibility norms does not entitle a candidate to be called for written test &/or interview. All the eligible candidates who apply and whose applications are received in time will be considered for selection process, which is as under:

Probationary Officer	Procedure consisting of (i) Preliminary Examination (ii) Main Examination & (iii) Interview. The Preliminary test will comprise of Objective test consisting of Test of Reasoning Ability, Test of Quantitative Aptitude and Test of English Language. Depending upon the number of vacancies, only a certain number of candidates from the candidates merit listed in the Preliminary Test will be called for the Main Examination. The Main Examination will consist of objective tests of Reasoning Ability, Quantitative Aptitude, General Awareness & Computer Knowledge and also a Descriptive Test. The question papers for both the examinations except the Objective test of English Language and Descriptive Paper of English Composition will be in bilingual i.e. Hindi & English version. Depending upon number of vacancies, only a certain number of candidates from the candidates merit listed in the Main Examination will be called for Interview. Final selection will be made on the basis of aggregate marks obtained by the candidates in the Main Examination & Interview and will be strictly according to the merit.

**Pre- Examination Training ( For Probationary Officers)**

It is proposed to impart free Pre- Examination Training to a limited number of Candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes/ Minority Communities on "First come first served basis" at Lucknow/ Kolkata/ Hyderabad/ Bhubaneswar/ Panchkula. **General Instructions :**

- The Bank takes no responsibility for any delay in receipt or loss in postal transit of any application or communication.
- Only candidates willing to serve anywhere in India should apply.
- Any resulting dispute arising out of this advertisement shall be subject to the sole jurisdiction of the Courts situated at Kolkata.
- No candidate is permitted to use calculators, mobile phones, pagers or any other instruments in the Examination Hall.
- canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
- A recent, recognizable passport size photograph should be firmly pasted on the application and should be signed across by the candidate. Four copies of the self attested photographs should be retained for use at the time of written examination and interview. Candidates are advised not to change their appearance till the recruitment process is complete. Failure to produce the same photograph at the time of written test/ interview may lead to disqualification.
- Before applying, the candidate should ensure that he/ she fulfills the eligibility and other norms mentioned in this advertisement. The Bank would be free to reject any application, at any stage of the recruitment process, if the candidate is found ineligible for the post for which he/ she has applied. In case of candidates belonging to OBC category, the certificate inter-alia must specify that the candidate does not belong to "Creamy Layer" section excluded from the benefits of the reservations for Other Backward Classes in Civil Post & Services under Government of India. **OBC certificate should not be more than one year old as on the date of application.**  
Copy of discharge certificate or any other relevant certificate in case of the Ex-serviceman
- Physically Challenged candidates claiming the benefit of reservations/ age relaxation should submit a copy of Medical Certificate as specified in the Persons with Disabilities Act of 1995 in support of their disability.
- An application not accompanied by requisite application fee and/ or postage, relevant certificate(s) – where necessary, or not in the prescribed format or not signed by the candidate or incomplete in any respect will not be entertained.**
- Candidates will have to appear for written test and/ or interview at their own expense. However, SC/ST candidates attending the interview after clearing the written test will be reimbursed 2nd class to & fro rail/ bus fare by the shortest route on production of evidence of travel.

Collector/ First Class Stipendary Magistrate/ Sub-Division Magistrate / Taluka Magistrate/ Executive Magistrate/ Extra Assistant Commissioner/ Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate/ Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar/ Sub Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/ or his/ her family normally resides.
- (b) For Physically Challenged – the Competent Authority to issue Disability Certificate shall be a Medical Board duly constituted by the Central or State Govt. The Central/ State Govt. may constitute Medical Boards consisting of at least 3 members out of which one shall be a specialist in the particular field for assessing locomotor/ cerebral/ visual/ hearing disability as the case may be.

**Action Against Candidates Found Guilty of Misconduct :**

Candidates are advised in their own interest that they should not furnish any particulars that are false, tampered, fabricated and should not surpass any material information while filling up the application form. At the time of written examination/ interview, if a candidate is (or has been ) found guilty of – (i) using unfair means during the examination or (ii) impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person or (iii) misbehaving in the examination hall or taking away the question booklet (or any part thereof ) / answer sheet from the examination hall or (iv) resorting to any irregular or improper means in connection with his/ her candidature for selection or (v) obtaining support for his/ her candidature by unfair means, such a candidate may, in addition to rendering himself/ herself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable :

- (a) to be disqualified from the examination for which he/ she is a candidate.
- (b) To be debarred either permanently or for a specified period from any examination or recruitment conducted by Allahabad Bank.
- (c) For termination of service, if he/ she has already joined the Bank.
